

### About the contents of the manual

Please read the product user manual carefully before installing and using this product, and keep the manual in a separate place for future reference.

#### Safety rules

#### 1. Explosive hazard

- This product complies with applicable standard code EN/IEC 60079-14, EN/IEC 60079-17, etc.
   Installation and maintenance must be performed by qualified personnel according to national standards.
- Do not open the product while power is supplied within an explosion-proof area.
- Installation of the product should be carried out using appropriate tools.
- The manufacturer recommends using explosion-proof tools.
- Connection testing and maintenance work in non-hazardous areas is recommended.
- Grounding is essential to reduce the risk of ignition of products installed in explosive environments.
- The device must be connected to protective earth.
- At this time, it is recommended to use an approved material for the grounding cable.
- Before turning on the product in a potentially explosive place, check that the connection parts such as cable glands are properly closed. Check it out.



#### Check the packing box

- When delivering the product, check that the packaging is intact and has not been dropped or torn.
- In the case of returning a broken product, we recommend that you reuse the packaging box provided for transportation. Recommended.
- The box label attached to the product box contains the information shown in the picture above.
- Before discarding the box, back up the information entered on the label to prevent product operation problems. wish.



### Select product installation location

When selecting a location to install the product, be sure to install it in a place that does not have any inconsistencies as in the case below.

#### Things to consider when installing the product




#### When selecting the initial location to install the product, consider the following.

- ① If the environment in which the product is installed is smaller than the bottom size of the product's mount bracket, there is a risk of the product falling, making it unsuitable for installation.
- ② Check if the size of the mounting part, such as the 'wall mount bracket' and H-beam, provided by the manufacturer is suitable for installation.
- 3 Check that the environment where the product is installed is not an area where lightning often occurs, and install it in a place where there is no influence of lightning if possible.
- (a) If the environment in which the product is installed receives many external factors such as high temperature, high humidity and low temperature due to direct sunlight, it is recommended to avoid this influence.
- (§) In preparation for the length of the wall bracket in the environment where the product is installed, the calculated length of the curvature of the product and flexible must be reflected and installed.
- 6 After receiving the product, be sure to remove the protective sponge inserted in the back of the cable gland to prevent damage to the cable sheath while moving the product.
- ① If the environment where the product is installed has severe vibration, it may affect the image, so it is recommended to install after attaching a device that can attenuate vibration such as a separate damper.
- (a) If the environment in which the product is installed is poor and the weight of the product (about 5Kg) cannot be supported, safety may be a problem, so it is recommended to install it in another safe place.



#### Installation using the product's mount bracket

#### Installation using wall mount brackets and ceiling brackets



- First, select the installation method from the picture above.
- Place the base bracket where it will be installed and mark the perforation point.
- Insert the knife block provided with the product into the perforation.
- Insert the cross piece provided with the product into the knife block position on the bracket.
- Loosen the bolts on the base bracket slightly to adjust the height and level of the video and finish.
- Equipment for wall perforation is not provided.



- The wall mount bracket can be fixed on a vertical wall.
- The sealing bracket can be fixed to the ceiling surface.
   Attach the bracket to the wall with the supplied set anchors capable of withstanding at least four times the weight of the unit. Please fix.
- Then, fix the device to the bracket using the supplied hex bolt SET.
   At this time, check that there are no foreign substances in the thread or fastening hole of the product.
- After applying enough locking compound (Loctite 263) on the 4 bolts, tighten the bolts.
   lock.
- The thread compound should set for one hour, during which time the installation should be completed.
- When tightening the bolts, tighten the torque to 35Nm.

The manufacturer is not responsible for product failure damage caused by lightning or surge caused by improper grounding of the product.


#### Wall Bracket Usage Guide

#### Ground (ground) installation



- When installing the two types of wall brackets provided by the manufacturer, depending on the wall bracket model
- It is recommended to install the camera through the method of ②, ③, ④ suggested in the manual.


The installer should be aware that the method ① is not applicable.



- Product grounding must be performed using an external cable (12AWG) with a cross section of 3mm<sup>2</sup>.
- The lug to be used for connection to the grounding power supply is connected to the grounding copper tube terminal provided with the product.
   Use the M5\*8 (wrench bolt) screw and fix it to the ground hole with the provided L wrench.
- A separate crimping machine is required for crimping copper tube terminals.
   At this time, the manufacturer does not provide a separate press.





When working with the network cable through the RJ-45 tool, it is essential to check through the tester as there is a possibility of network failure due to miswiring or operator error.

#### Configuration diagram for each built-in cable



- The IVEX-EMC-300 Teflon cable in ① is a dedicated 8P network cable.


  Therefore, according to the site situation, after cutting according to the length of the cable, refer to the line arrangement in the figure ①. Cable length can be adjusted.
- The IVEX-EMC-A302 explosion-proof armored cable in ② is a dedicated 8P network explosion-proof cable.

Therefore, according to the site situation, after cutting according to the length of the cable, refer to the line arrangement in the figure 1. Cable length can be adjusted

- The IVEX-EMC-200 multi-cable in 3 is a multi-output cable.

Therefore, it is impossible to adjust the length, and the length initially provided by the manufacturer is used. Any excess length of cable must be handled inside the joint box. Also, this cable needs to be connected with the OUTPUT cable, and this connection must be made with a joint It must be done inside the box.

#### Connection diagram between joint boxes



- Like ①, PoE connection can be made using the terminal block inside the joint box.
 At this time, No. 4,5 of the RJ45 array are '+' and No. 7,8 are '-', and No. 1,2,3,6 are connected to the terminal block.

Connect 1, 2, 3, 4, pair 4, 5 to 5, pair 7, 8 and connect to 6 Can be used.

 - As shown in ②, you can use the RJ45 connector as it is and use a coupler to connect easily. can.

However, coupler terminals may be corroded due to moisture in the joint box, which may cause poor contact. there is.

- As shown in ③, multi-cables can be connected to each cable connected to the explosion-proof junction box. there is.

At this time, after connecting the CVBS (or AHD output) terminal and RS-485 terminal, be sure to insulate them.


It is taped with tape, and it is taped in the same way after connecting multiple cables. to maintain insulation from external leakage current.

### Maintenance after product installation

When replacing or maintaining the camera, be sure to move to a safe area, not an explosion-proof area.

#### Periodic cleaning

#### Disassembly/assembly of products for inspection



- Regular cleaning should be performed so that no more than 5mm of dust accumulates on the surface of the product. do. (for anti-static purposes)
- Tempered Glass Glass should be cleaned with mild soapy water diluted with water.
- Be sure to clean the surface of the device with a damp cloth.




- After separating the sun shield and mount bracket as shown in ①, disassemble the ring bracket and remove the bolts on the exterior. Remove all.
- As shown in ②, remove the head bolt on the top of the main body and turn the main body clockwise. disassemble.
- You can inspect the module inside by disassembling the front cover + main body assembly as shown in ③. there is.
- When disassembling the product, it must be disassembled/inspected in a place without ambient moisture, and For dew condensation caused by moisture inflow during disassembly/inspection, the manufacturer not responsible.


### Network Connection and Setup

You can set the network environment of the camera according to the user's network connection configuration.

#### Installing the camera directly in a LAN environment

#### Installing the camera directly in a LAN environment





- Run the Internet browser of the local PC.
- Enter the IP address of the camera you want to access in the browser's address bar.
- From a remote PC on the external Internet in a LAN environment to a camera installed in a LAN environment When connecting, if port forwarding is not done or if a firewall is installed, the connection is not possible. may not be
   In this case, contact your network administrator.
- When the product is shipped, the IP address is a fixed IP as in 'Checking product operation information and appearance status' It is set.

#### Tip

 If you lose the box or tag displaying the IP address, ID, and PW, you can contact us through the manufacturer's website.
 You can download the IP Search program.

- Direct connection between user computer and network camera.
- Use the IP Search program to find the IP address of the camera from the user's computer to the Internet.

Change it to an IP address that can be accessed through a browser.

- Connect to the web viewer using an internet browser.
- Move to the [Setup] page.
- Go to [Network] [DDNS] setting page and set DDNS.
- [Basic] Go to the [IP & Port] setting page and set the IP type to [DHCP].
- Disconnect the camera from the user's computer and connect it directly to the modem.
- Reboot the camera

#### Tip

- Disposal of the device must be properly disposed of in accordance with the e-waste guidelines and environmental regulations.

### Network Connection and Setup (IVEX-PL-10 Series)

The IP address range of the user's computer and the IP address range of the camera must match for normal web viewer access.

#### Using the IP Search program



- Click the icon such as  $\ensuremath{ \mathbb{O}}$  on the IP Search program downloaded to the user's computer Run.
- When the IP Search program is executed, click ② icon to start IP search. If the IP address is normally searched as shown in ③, double-click the searched IP address to open the web viewer. can connect. (default IP address: 10.20.30.40 / ID: root / PW: root)
- If you need to change the IP address, click the corresponding icon as (4) in the IP Search program. Click to change IP address.

#### Tip

- HTTP Port: HTTP used when accessing the camera using an Internet browser Port, the initial value is 80.
- RTSP Port: This is the port that controls real-time streaming, and the initial value is 554..

#### PC network settings depending on whether an IP sharer is used



- As in ①, connect to the internal network settings of the user's router.
   (The menu name or access method may differ depending on the router manufacturer.)
- IP Address: Set according to the private IP range provided by the IP sharer. Ex) 192.168.1.2~254, 192.168.0.2~254, 192.168.XXX.2~254
- Subnet Mask: If the <Subnet Mask> of the IP router is the <Subnet Mask> of the camera It's possible.
- Gateway: The IP router's <Local IP Address> becomes the camera's <Gateway> value.
- 2) Check if the IP settings of the same band are set in the network settings of the user's computer. Check.

#### Tip

 If there are more than 2 cameras, camera 1 (192.168.0.3), camera 2 (192.168.0.4), etc. Set different IP addresses and use the same subnet mask and gateway.

### Network Connection and Setup (IVEX-PL-10 Series)

Web viewer access can be checked in normal operation through Google Chrome and Microsoft Edge browsers.

#### Web viewer access



- Run a web browser such as Chrome or Edge on the user's computer.
- Enter the IP address set on the camera into the web browser address bar.
- If you connect to the camera normally as in 1 and press the 'LIVE' button on the top left of the screen, the same as 2
- The ID/PW input window is executed, and input the initial ID/PW 'root'. (For security, be sure to change the initial ID/PW after setting.)
- As shown in ③, you can check the OSD window for PTZ control along with the output of the live screen. there is.

#### Tip

When operating the web viewer in Internet Explorer 11, 'Active X' must be downloaded and executed.

#### **Change IP Settings in Web Viewer**



- There is a SETUP menu that displays the 'ADMIN' icon in ① on the live screen. Now.
- You cannot go back to the static IP and DHCP status for the camera IP address by clicking the 'IP Address' menu.
- it's okay. Static IP allows you to change your IP address.
- When all changes are complete, click the 'Apply' button to save the settings.
- After 30 seconds, you can connect to the changed IP address in your web browser.


#### Tip

If the IP address you want to change is an IP address that is being used by another device in the same band You may not be able to access the web viewer due to an IP conflict

### Network Connection and Setup (IVEX-PL-10 Series)

When setting RTSP, you must first check if the '554 PORT' of the router is open.

#### RTSP settings



- Service: Set whether to use RTP/RTSP.
- RTSP Port: Sets the RTSP Port. The default value is 554.
- Packet Size: This is the menu to set the Packet Size to be transmitted via RTP/RTSP.
   If the value is low, compatibility with many S/Ws is maintained. It divides and transmits small amount of packets.

The higher the value, the fewer packets are divided and transmitted

- However, if the program does not support a high value, no video is displayed.
- Keep-Alive: Sends the current camera status through continuous UDP communication. Some S/W and equipment are not supported.
- RTP Auth Algorithm: Determines the RTP encryption authentication method.
- MD5 is highly compatible with many S/W. If set to SHA256, stronger encryption is applied, but It cannot be played on S/W or devices that do not support SHA256, such as VLC.



#### Firmware update method

- When the IP Search program is executed, click the search button as shown in ② to start IP search. If the IP address is normally searched as shown in ③, double-click the searched IP address to open the web viewer. can connect.
- When the input window like @ appears, enter ID / PW. (default IP address: 192.168.1.10 / ID: admin / PW: 1234)
- If you need to change the IP address, set the corresponding camera as in (§) in the IP Search program. You can change the IP address by clicking on the search content.

#### Tip

- HTTP Port: HTTP used when accessing the camera using an Internet browser Port, the initial value is 80.
- RTSP Port: This is the port that controls real-time streaming. The initial value is 554.

#### PC network settings depending on whether an IP sharer is used



- As in ①, connect to the internal network settings of the user's router.
   (The menu name or access method may differ depending on the router manufacturer.)
- IP Address: Set according to the private IP range provided by the IP sharer. Ex) 192.168.1.2~254, 192.168.0.2~254, 192.168.XXX.2~254
- Subnet Mask: If the <Subnet Mask> of the IP router is the <Subnet Mask> of the camera It's possible.
- Gateway: The IP router's <Local IP Address> becomes the camera's <Gateway> value.
- 2) Check if the IP settings of the same band are set in the network settings of the user's computer. Check.

#### Tip

 If there are more than 2 cameras, camera 1 (192.168.0.3), camera 2 (192.168.0.4), etc. Set different IP addresses and use the same subnet mask and gateway.

#### Web viewer access



- Run a web browser such as Chrome or Edge on the user's computer.



4	Depending on the input specifications of the separate power supply or the power supply (SMPS) supplied by the manufacturer and the PoE injector Connect with care.	
5	Pay attention to the polarity (+, -) of the data line (RS-485) and connect it to the connection terminal correctly.	
6	If applicable, properly connect the video cable (BNC terminal) to the recorder or monitor to check normal video output.	
7	Connect the CAT.5 cable (RJ-45 Jack) to the connection terminal correctly and check that video and control operate normally under the optimal network environment.	
8	Check/set if the ZOOM IN/OUT control protocol and control baud rate match the NVR or communication equipment you are using.	
9	If applicable, check IR-LED operation.	
10	Make a final check to see if there are any abnormalities in the zoom / video / control status.	


